

Logos License Policy

Many Northwest programs require the use of Logos. If a version of sufficient quality is not already owned by a student in these programs, one must be purchased. Northwest has arranged for a custom Logos package to be available to students at a significantly discounted price.

Students whose programs do not require Logos, along with mentors, may opt to purchase Northwest's custom Logos package and will receive Northwest's special pricing.

All those who require or wish to purchase Logos must pay the cost in full to Northwest. After payment has been received, a permanent Logos license will be issued to the individual.

For select Northwest programs, the cost of the Logos program and library is incorporated into the program's tuition fees. For these programs, students will receive a temporary Logos license at the start of their first term of study. Upon the successful completion of their program, these students will have their Logos license converted to a permanent license, which the student will then fully own and control. If the student withdraws and does not successfully complete the program, the Logos license will be revoked, and the individual will no longer have access. A student who is withdrawing from the program may opt to purchase the Logos license from Northwest by informing Northwest's registrar of this decision prior to formal withdrawal. In such a case, the student will pay the remaining balance owing on their Logos license, and the license will be converted from a temporary to a permanent license.
